Veterans and Surviving Spouses can be eligible for money to help pay for their care

Aid and Attendance 2020 Monthly Amounts

Helps to pay for long term care

Married Veteran - \$2266.00 (\$27,192 Yearly)

Single Veteran - \$1911.00 (\$22,932 Yearly)

Surviving Spouse - \$1228.00 (\$14,736 Yearly)



Qualifications

Each case is different, so better talk to us about your individual situation

Requirement	Details
Service	90 Days of Service one day during a war Combat not required
Need for Aid	Living in an assisted living or nursing home, or receiving home care in your home, or getting help from a friend or family member in your home.
Financial Limits	If you fit the Service requirements and the need for aid, income & assets should not hold you back from getting the benefits, if you do the proper planning.

World War I: April 6, 1917, through November 11, 1918

World War II: December 7, 1941, through December 31, 1946

Korean War: June 27, 1950, through January 31, 1955

Vietnam War: August 5, 1964 (February 28, 1961, for veterans who served "in country" before August 5, 1964), through May 7, 1975

Persian Gulf War: August 2, 1990, through a date to be set by Presidential Proclamation or Law
